The Sanborn City Council met in open session for a special meeting on Friday, May 25th, 2018 at the Sanborn City Hall in the Donald Kroese Council Chambers. Mayor VanVeldhuizen called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. with the following Council present: Brian Visser, Tim Devitt, Jerry Back, Randy Lyman, and Dave Marra. Others present: Scott Chrisman, Paul Schuler, Peg Japenga and Jim Zeutenhorst by phone.

Paul Schuler presented to the council that the Sanborn Ambulance was in need of some major repairs. Two options were discussed: 1. Install a new transmission, radiator, cooler and a few other minor repairs suggested by Morgan Collison & Tire Service in Sheldon with an estimate of \$6000 and rent an ambulance while ours is being repaired with an estimate of \$2350. 2. Purchase a new chassis with all equipment changed over, full warranties, lights installed and paint for quote of \$69,000.

Motion Lyman, seconded by Marra to elect option 1 and make the necessary repairs needed to the ambulance and upon the roll being called, the following named members of the Council voted:

AYES: Brian Visser, Dave Marra, Tim Devitt, Randy Lyman, and Jerry Back

NAYES: None Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion was held on adding to the bike trail at Miller Park along Western and 1st Street, a map was handed out on a suggested route. Legal right-a-ways and crossings are still being investigated with the railroad. The 1st street project and the Maris Estates project are both under way and going as expected.

The next regular City Council meeting will be scheduled for Monday, June 11th, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of Sanborn City Hall.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Motion Devitt, seconded by Marra to adjourn at 2:45 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.
